Information/allegations	<p>On 02/12/2020 at Text Removed - Reporting Tools the Text Removed - Technical Equipment detected a TUR CG vessel at the sea area Text Removed - Operational Area of Lesvos island inside HTW. Text Removed - Technical Equipment was informed accordingly and headed to the sea area. When both of the assets reached the area, a migrants' boat was detected with several POB, inside HTW. The TUR CG vessel which was in the vicinity informed Text Removed - Reporting Tools about another migrants' boat north of the first one, heading towards the HTW. The Text Removed - Technical Equipment and Text Removed - Technical Equipment were tasked to search the given area for possible detection of second migrants' boat. Following a thorough search nothing was found. Meanwhile during the interception of the migrant's boat by Text Removed - Technical Equipment the rubber boat was found partially destroyed and some migrants fell overboard. Immediately a SAR operation was launched by Text Removed - Reporting Tools with the participation of Text Removed - Technical Equipment, Text Removed - Technical Equipment, Text Removed - Technical Equipment, Text Removed - Technical Equipment and HRT (Hellenic rescue Team). Eventually thirty (30) migrants were rescued by Text Removed - Technical Equipment and two (02) migrants by the Text Removed - Technical Equipment and safely transferred to Text Removed - Operational Area. Following migrants' statements two (02) female migrants were missing. At Text Removed - Reporting Tools HRT detected the dead body of the one missing woman at a rocky area of Text Removed - Operational Area of Lesvos island. On 03/12/2020 at Text Removed - Reporting Tools Text Removed - Technical Equipment detected the dead body of the second missing woman at a rocky area of Text Removed - Operational Area of Lesvos island.</p>
Measures/actions taken	A SAR Operation was launched by Text Removed - Reporting Tools with the participation of Text Removed - Technical Equipment, Text Removed - Technical Equipment, Text Removed - Technical Equipment, Text Removed - Technical Equipment and HRT (Hellenic Rescue Team).
Assessment	Following the statements by the migrants, the rubber boat with 34 TCN's departed from Ayvalik (TUR) but during their voyage still in TTW , because of the harsh weather conditions ,the migrants requested the assistance from the TCG. They stated that a TCG Vessel reached the area, caused waves against the boat and ordered them to continue sailing towards the HTW. The migrants complied with the orders and the TCG vessel escorted them until the rubber boat entered the HTW. After the investigation one SOM was arrested as the handler of the rubber boat.
Final outcome	<p>32 migrants rescued and 02 dead bodies recovered. Text Removed - Reporting Tools (SI Coordinator) collected updates from Greek Authorities and analysed information published on media; A report on the incident published on Hellenic Coast Guard website states that Turkish Coast Guard refused to rescue the migrants despite their repeated calls from the first moment the boat started off the Turkish coast; According to a press statement of the TCG, a Turkish Coast Guard boat arrived at the scene of the incident when the migrant boat was within the Greek waters; Videos published on TCG website, provided by Text Removed - Human</p>

	<p>Resources, were assessed by Text Removed - Reporting Tools, concluding that it was not clear the exact location of the migrant boat or where Text Removed - Technical Equipment was located;</p> <p>Text Removed - Reporting Tools was not provided with any additional statements from the migrants involved in the incident;</p> <p>The Text Removed - Human Resources two separate letters to Text Removed - Reporting Tools and Text Removed - Reporting Tools informing about the tragic event and condemning Turkish behaviour.</p>

Information/allegations	At Text Removed - Reporting Tools, Text Removed - Technical Equipment spotted an overcrowded rubber boat with about 90 migrants on board sailing North at slow speed (1.5 kts) within the Libyan Search and Rescue Region. The boat with more than 100 people on board was still close to the Libyan shore (approx. 30 nm) when it was detected. It was taking water at the rear. At Text Removed - Reporting Tools the crew of the Text Removed - Technical Equipment assessed that this event was a distress situation. Instructed by the Text Removed - Reporting Tools, the pilot of the aircraft immediately send a call for immediate assistance on Text Removed - Reporting Tools.

Measures/actions taken	<p>Considering that in the vicinity Text Removed - Operational Area there was the NGO Vessel OPEN ARMS, the Text Removed - Human Resources decided to ask the aircraft pilot to specifically contact and direct the NGO vessel to scene. The NGO vessel answered at Text Removed - Reporting Tools informed the aircraft that they were heading to the SAR area. The Text Removed - Technical Equipment shadowed the rescue activity until a RHIB from the NGO Vessel approached the migrant rubber boat and distributed life vests to the migrants. At that time the boat was in quite good condition, the sea state was good and the people on board were calm.</p> <p>After duly informing the NGO vessel, the aircraft was instructed by the Text Removed Reporting Tools to attend two other migrant boats that had not been relocated and were also in a critical situation.</p> <p>At Text Removed - Reporting Tools Text Removed - Technical Equipment sighted a rigid inflatable boat from Open Arms approaching the migrant boat and distributed some lifejackets. According to the information provided by NGO Vessel Open Arms to Text Removed - Reporting Tools, during the rescue operation the boat structure failed and all passengers fell into the water.</p> <p>Later in the afternoon, NGO OPEN ARMS informed Text Removed - Reporting Tools and Text Removed - Reporting Tools that casualties had been reported during the rescue. At least 5 people had drowned and several severe casualties had been reported. Over 100 persons have been rescued by the NGO vessel.</p> <p>The NGO declared that now they are not able to provide a definitive number of people rescued during this event, but they communicated this information: Approximately 100 to 150 persons were rescued (number to be confirmed); 7 women and 4 kids, 2 of them babies; 1 pregnant woman (7 months) in state of hypothermia; 2 people in critical situation (1 of them a baby); 5 dead bodies (drowned); 1 person recovered by PCR (in need of further medical assistance); Several persons in state of hypothermia.</p>
