Fact of the case

At 18:38 local time, Italian Coast Guard requested to verify the position because a merchant vessel "SEYIT ALI" detected a boat in distress with migrants in the sea. ICC Coordinator gave the instruction to verify the position to the Icelandic National Officer. ICE/FWA and n. 2 CPVs of Italian Coast Guard went on the spot. The naval assets rescued 12 migrants and found 1 dead body. The boat was sunk.
