Hi,

Having read the article provided by Text Removed – Personal Data: between 800 and 1,000 immigrants of sub-Saharan origin had tried to enter Melilla illegally in the last week. Until now, the Moroccan Security Forces had avoided it, with the result of almost 200 wounded agents, but this morning about 220(of which about 70 have been rejected at the border) have managed to stage a jump in the Chinatown area.
