
Statistical data visualization

- A web-based application for accessing up-to-date data and statistics based on data reported in IRMA
 - Available under **Statistical data visualization** tab
 - Two types of access rights:
 - data visualization only
 - data visualization and creating own reports
- According to the Data Policy, all MSs have access to their own and other MSs data

How can you use the service?


- **Data visualization only**
 - ✓ Visualize existing statistical reports
 - ✓ Print a statistical report
 - ✓ Use filters
- **Creating own reports**
 - ✓ Create tables, charts, maps, tree maps, world clouds, etc.
 - ✓ Apply filters and rank the data
 - ✓ Set-up interactions between objects in the dashboard
 - ✓ Formatting
 - ✓ Save the report in “My folder” only
 - ✓ Ask Frontex to publish the report to be visible for other colleagues


