Subject: DEPORTATION FROM LESVOS GREECE WHILE INTERIM MEASURES PENDING

To whom it may concern,

I am one of the coordinators of the pro bono legal aid project of NGO [REDACTED] which is implemented on the islands of the Aegean. On the context of this project, we legally represent a man from [REDACTED], for whom judicial proceedings for temporary protection before the competent courts are pending. His details are [REDACTED] and his police number [REDACTED].

As we were informed by the police authorities, the above mentioned person is included on Friday's (15/11/2019) readmission of third countries nationals to Turkey from the island of Lesvos Greece, despite the fact that a decision for his application of annulment and interim measures against his deportation process as well as his rejection of his asylum application by Appeals Authority are pending before the national courts.

Yesterday (12/11/2019) he submitted an application of annulment and application of suspension and interim measures against the decision that rejects his asylum application on second instance before the competent court of the Appeals Court of Peiraius. The procedure for granting interim measures and suspension of the rejective second instance decision, is pending and no decision has been issued while Greek Law sets concrete timelines for the issuance of such decision on behalf of the competent Appeals Court according to article 15 par. 5 L. 3068/2002 article, as amended by 29 par. 2 L 4540/2018, timelimits that there are not exceeded

Therefore, any action of forced removal of the above mention person while his application for granting suspension and interim measures is still pending, violates his right to judicial protection

In the light of the above, we request that his upcoming readmission not to be materialized and that he will not be deported while the above process is still pending
