Dear Mr Semsrott,

On 15 May 2019, you submitted a complaint to the European Ombudsman against the European Commission. I have been assigned responsibility for your case.

Your complaint concerns the Commission's failure to register and deal with your request for public access to "*all valid E-DOMEC training course manuals and all manuals on registration, filing and preservation of information*", which you made in electronic form using the FragDenStaat-website.

The Commission refused to register your request and asked you to re-send it using its online form. You would like the Commission to register your request and to deal with it under Regulation 1049/2001.

On the Ombudsman's behalf, I have contacted the Commission to explore the possibility of resolving your complaint swiftly. This is in line with the principle, set out in Regulation 1049/2001, that applications for access to documents should be handled promptly.

I will get back to you as soon as I am in a position to update you on the progress of the case.
