



**DECISION OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR  
ON APPOINTMENT OF DOCUMENT ACCESS COORDINATOR**

*EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE EUROPEAN GNSS AGENCY (GSA)*

HAVING REGARD to the Regulation (EU) No 912/2010 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 September 2010 setting up the European GNSS Agency as amended by the Regulation (EU) No 512/2014 of 16 April 2016 (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulation (EU) No 912/2010"), and notably Article 8 (d), (i) and (o) and Article 21 thereof,

HAVING REGARD to the Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 May 2001 regarding public access to European Parliament, Council and Commission documents,

HAVING REGARD to the Decision of the Administrative Board of the European GNSS Agency of 18 June 2018 approving the Policy on Public Access to Documents at the European GNSS Agency (hereinafter referred to as the "Decision"), and notably Article 3(1) thereof,

**WHEREAS**

- (1) By adopting the Decision, the Administrative Board, in compliance with Article 21 of the Regulation (EU) No 912/2010, adopted the arrangements for implementing Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001.
- (2) The Decision introduces the role of Document Access Coordinator, who shall carry out certain activities related to ensuring public access to the documents.
- (3) In particular, Document Access Coordinator shall be responsible for assessing initial applications for documents and for preparing the decisions of the Executive Director with respect to confirmatory applications.
- (4) The Document Access Coordinator shall be designated by the Executive Director.
- (5) Mr David Petrлік has a profile required for this role.
- (6) Mr Petrлік's interests have been heard and considered and he raised no objections,

**HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:**


**Article 1**

Mr David Petrлік is hereby designated as Document Access Coordinator.
