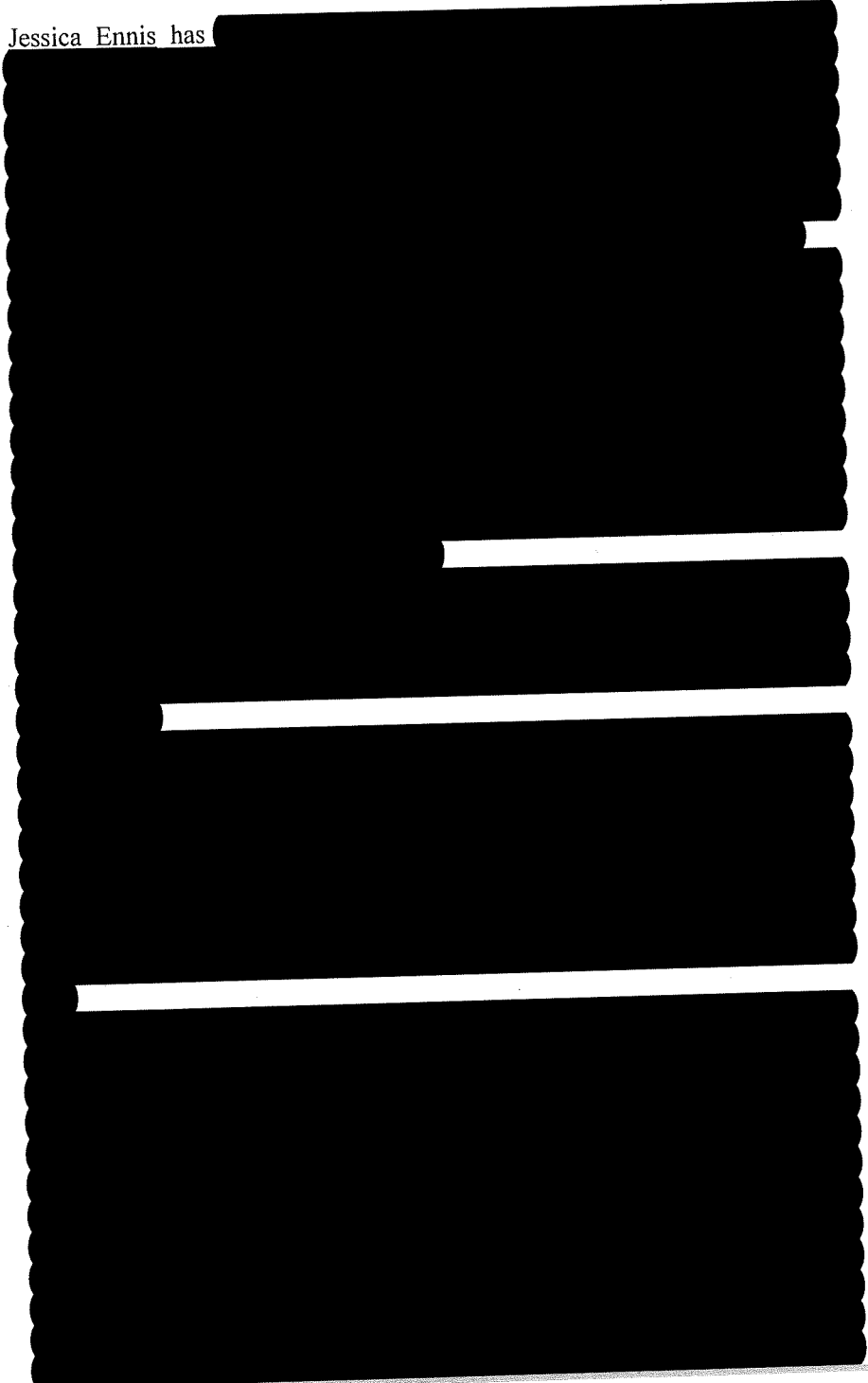

1. 17 *The Sun* mainstream British tabloid newspaper comparable to *Bild* in Germany
1. 20 ginger *here:* referring to a person with red hair
1. 28 Wiggins / Hoy famous British winners of Olympic gold in 2012 – with no immigrant or mixed race background; Wiggins also won the *Tour de France* in 2012.
1. 30 *Britain Thinks* a British organisation that carries out surveys
