Information/allegations

At 0134hrs (Text Removed - Justification 6) Text Removed - Justification 5, identified an small migrant vessel (possible rubber boat) heading 214(T) at 2.0knots. Immediately informed Text Removed - Justification 4 who declared a SOLAS SAR incident. Arrive on scene at 0150hrs, vessel stopped in water and not making way. Positively identified migrant vessel as 4m plastic GRP craft with 23 migrants on board. Since the vessel looked overcrowded and unseaworthy at 02:00 hrs. commenced the transfer of migrants that ended up at 02:30 hrs. During this SAR operation a Text Removed - Justification 4 suffered small injures in one of his legs. According with the last info provided by the Text Removed - Justification 4, they expect that 2-3 days resting at the hotel room will be enough for his recovery.
