Current Deployment

Six bases in five countries have nuclear weapons today

150 weapons remain
(possibly only 100)

All stored in underground vaults
(WS3) inside shelters

Six other bases have empty vaults

Weapons are B61-3/4 gravity bombs

Yields: 0.3 kt – 170 kt (B61-3)
0.3 kt – 50 kt (B61-4)

For delivery by US F-15E/-16 and
NATO F-16, PA-200
