



We refer to your e-mail of 22 March 2020 in which you make a request for access to documents, registered on 31 March 2020 under the above-mentioned reference number, and with number Ref. Ares(2020)185663.

We regret to inform you that the Commission does not hold any documents that would correspond to the description given in your application.

With respect to this Access to Documents request, there is no document produced by the Commission assessing the implications of US counter-terrorism legislation on judicial cooperation. Nor does the Commission hold any document concerning detention conditions in certain US prisons.

Given that no such documents, corresponding to the description given in your application, are held by the Commission, the Commission is not in a position to fulfil your request.

In accordance with Article 7(2) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001, you are entitled to make a confirmatory application requesting the Commission to review this position.
