In the letter dated 23 November 2017, EMSA informed you that the tests and deliverables were partially accepted up to % of the required capabilities.

In accordance with this partial acceptance the Agency has considered that Leonardo Helicopters was ready to provide RPAS services under the contract in reference as per mobilisation alert sent on 31st of October 2017 (Italy). This readiness for operations was however condition

Moreover, this partial system acceptance was also conditional to the installation of all those devices, such as which are needed for the execution of flights over sea in safety (as per Leonardo's internal safety guidelines).

On 18 December 2017, EMSA sent a new reminder to Leonardo Finmeccanica indicating that the conditions described above had not been achieved. As a consequence EMSA had withdrawn the offer to Specific Contract No 3 as well as the Specific Contract No 2 for interfacing and announced its intention to terminate the FWC unless deliverables would be completed within one month of that letter (by 17 January 2018).

Further to that Letter, a meeting was held in EMSA premises on 10 January 2018 and you sent a letter dated 12 January 2018 where you indicated that advancements in the ITAR issue resolution and in the obtainment of the Permit to Fly were made. However, in the same letter,

In line with the discussion that took place between Leonardo and EMSA in Lisbon on 10th January 2018, and in consideration of the ongoing actions undertaken after that meeting and relevant progresses, Leonardo respectfully requires EMSA to consider the temporary suspension of the notified termination of the subject Framework Contract.

In case EMSA would favorably consider this request, Leonardo commits to keep EMSA informed of the progress against the planned activities identified during the 10th January meeting to allow EMSA to decide if and when surveillance services may be called upon.

Leonardo would like EMSA to positively evaluate this proposal also in consideration of the significant amount of resources that Leonardo dedicated for the development of this program and the extra endeavors implemented for the recovery of the unexpected events that negatively impacted the delivery schedule, as detailed by Leonardo during the previous meetings and communications and promptly reported to EMSA along with the appropriate mitigation plans. Please note that the investments made by Leonardo to enable EMSA services to be conducted under the Framework Contract amount to in excess of

Dear

Thank you for your letter dated 7 February 2018.

In the letter dated 26 January 2018, EMSA informed you that the mobilization alert for the operation in Italy was cancelled. In the same letter EMSA informed you about the termination of the Framework Contract 2017/EMSA/OP/12/2016-Lot 3 due the limitations of additional platform for maritime applications and the announced delay in the production of additional which are a breach of substantial contractual obligations.

The achievements described in your letter dated 7 February 2018 were already presented to EMSA at the meeting held in EMSA on 10 January 2018. Availability of an aircraft capable to perform RPAS maritime operations only as from April 2018 is not respecting the terms of the Contract as already communicated at the meeting.

We would like to recall that:

- 1) All activities/services related to the incraft (the interim solution until the will be available for operations) were supposed to be ready by 30 June 2017, which already includes one extension of 25 days;
- 2) after two reminder letters by EMSA, the acceptance tests took place on 16 and 17 October 2017;
- EMSA sent a mobilisation alert for operation in Italy on 31 October 2017 and after the partial acceptance on 23 November 2017 EMSA sent the Specific Contract No 3 for signature while reiterating several conditions to be respected;

4) Based on the lack of progress, EMSA withdrew Specific Contract No3 as well as Specific Contract No2 for interfacing on 18 December 2017 and announced its intention to terminate the FWC, unless deliverables were completed by 18 January 2018.

EMSA underlines again that the 2017/EMSA/OP/12/2016-Lot 3 is finally terminated due to a manifest noncompliance to the agreed contractual terms for the provision of an operational system/service.

In spite of this, we still look forward to collaborate with Leonardo Helicopters in any future project.
