Dear Secretary-General,

Thank you very much for your letter of 3 June 2020 in which you express your wish for progress in the implementation of a Joint Legislative Portal.

I fully agree that this is a worthwhile reflection which could contribute not only to the transparency of the legislative process but could also help improve its efficiency to the benefit of the institutions.

The European Parliament therefore proposes a solution, based on this Institution's well-established experience with the communication of the legislative process. Such a solution would rely in the design of its interface on the latest know-how in human/computer interaction, would use already operational and well-tested interinstitutional communication links and data exchange protocols and would be conceived in an institutionally neutral way.

In order to find a way forward, I suggest discussing the matter at one of our regular meetings after the summer recess where we could explore various options and find a solution that all our institutions could support.
