Dear Ms Montserrat,



These petitions, notified in real-time in GEDA to the Petitions Committee Secretariat, are filed under three main categories (3.1, 3.2 and 3.3).

It should be emphasized that the categorisation of petitions on the List 3 is only a suggestion from my services. The sole purpose is to alert the Secretariat of the Committee you chair, to petitions which could be treated with a curtailed procedure.
