Information/allegations

On 07/09/2018 the Text Removed - Human Resources in the Text Removed - Reporting Tools received information by passing drivers about a traffic accident (a truck with FYROM number plates crushed into a GRC registered vehicle). Both vehicles were on the direction towards Thessaloniki in Egnatia Highway and according to the statements of the truck driver (FYROM national) the GRC registered vehicle had broken down and stopped in Egnatia Highway having no lights. Five (5) persons (4 male, 1 female) were on board in the GRC registered vehicle while the driver (facilitator) escaped and was not detected after the crush. Four (4) of them were transported to Alexandroupolis Hospital in order to receive the proper medical treatment, and one (1) was transported to the

	hospital in Komotini, seriously injured. All of them remain hospitalized. Four (4 of them are AFG nationals and one (1) is PAK national. No travel documents were found. All of them have been apprehended for illegal entry from BCU Text removed - Operational Area. The investigation is still ongoing.
Measures/actions taken	All the persons remain hospitalized (4 in Alexandroupolis hospital, 1 in Komotini hospital) in order to receive the proper medical treatment.
Assessment	UPDATED INFORMATION (14.9.2018): Three (3) persons remain hospitalized in Alexandroupolis' Hospital, one (1) seriously injured is under intensive care and the other two (2) are slightly injured and soon are going to be out of the hospital.

Text Removed - Technical Equipment, Text Removed - Technical Equipment and Text Removed - Technical Equipment were dispatched. At 17:00 LT, Text Removed - Technical Equipment detected a migrant boat which was sinking Text Removed - Operational Area. Due to the emergency situation, Text Removed - Technical Equipment throwed a inflatable raft to the migrants below. Text Removed - Technical Equipment arrived to the position at 18:55 LT and rescued 52 POB, 05 corpses were also recovered. Afterwards, Text Removed - Technical Equipment detected another migrant boat in distress. Another inflatable raft was throwed from Text Removed - Technical Equipment. Text Removed - Technical Equipment assited with the opeartion throwing another inflatable raft. Text Removed - Technical Equipment headed to the spot and once at it, rescued 50 POB.

Information/allegations

On 31/08/2018 at 14:00 the Text Removed - Human Resources of the Text Removed - Reporting Tools PD Alexandroupolis received information by passing drivers about a vehicle (Text Removed - Reporting Tools) that had bumped into the barriers in Egnatia Highway with twenty four (24) persons (males) on board according to the information reported by Text Removed - Human Resources on the spot. Seven (7) of them were transported to Alexandroupolis Hospital, two (2) of them seriously injured and five (5) slightly injured in order to receive the proper medical treatment and they all remain hospitalized. Additionally, seventeen (17) persons have been transported to BCU Text Removed - Operational Area and they have been apprehended for illegal entry. No travel

documents have been found. All the apprehended persons claim to be from Bangladesh (BGD). The nationalities of the seven (7) injured persons are unknown at this moment, the investigation is still ongoing. The driver of the vehicle (facilitator) escaped according to the statements of the apprehended persons.

All the persons have been transferred to Alexandroupolis hospital in order to receive the proper medical treatment. According to the information received on 5.9.2018 from Text Removed - Reporting Tools, all hospitalized persons has been released from the hospital and brought to Text Removed - Operational Area for further national procedures.

All of the hospitalized persons are out of the hospital on 05/09/2018 after having received the proper medical treatment and on 06/09/2018 they are going to be transported to Text Removed - Operational Area following the procedures according to the national legislation.
