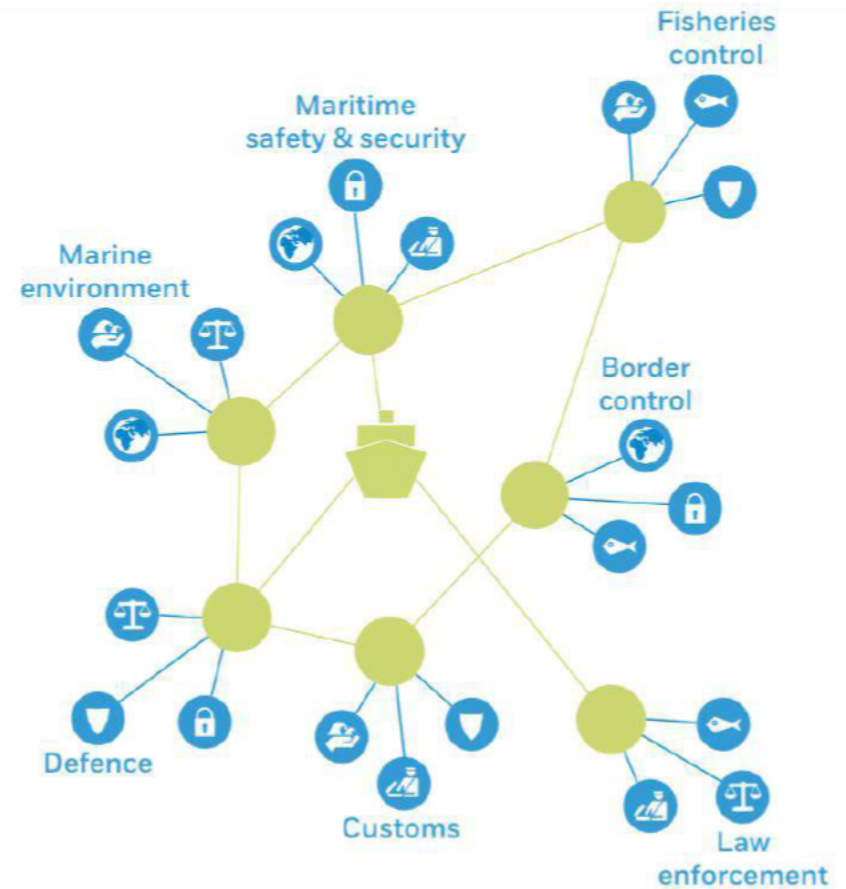
Strengthening maritime security contributed to:
