Your application for access to European Border and Coast Guard Agency (Frontex) documents

Dear Mr/Ms Izuzquiza,

In reference to your application registered on 20 October 2021 for which the time limit has been extended by 15 working days on 15 November 2021¹, asking for access to

- all correspondence including, but not limited to, all e-mails, messages, notes, letters, phone call logs, and all attachments sent or received by Frontex, both to and from external and internal parties, from 20 October 2021 to date, with regards to the above-mentioned payment and/or any related matters. This includes, but is not limited to, all communications among the Frontex Accounting Office with other Frontex units or Liaison Office(r)s. This also includes all communication exchanged between Frontex and other EU agencies with regards to the above-mentioned payment and/or any related matters. This also includes, but is not limited to, all communications regarding, discussing or mentioning payments in cash, including at Frontex premises.
- all documents exchanged including draft statements, background notes, or any other document mentioning or describing the above-mentioned payment of fees from 20 October 2021 to date.

Please find two of the three documents pertaining to your application herewith attached with redactions pertaining to personal data, such as names of individuals and/or characteristic features. Their disclosure would undermine the protection of privacy and the integrity of the individual, in particular in accordance with European Union legislation regarding the protection of personal data and therefore has to be precluded pursuant to Article 4(1)(b) of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001.

As correspondents to one document, you are already in possession - outside the framework of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001 - of the remaining document.

Kindly be reminded that the copyright of the document/s rests with Frontex and making this/these work/s, available to third parties in this or another form without prior authorisation of Frontex is prohibited. Please also note that Frontex does not assume liability stemming from the use of the document/s.
