The Commissioner agrees on the need to engage with private sector, we need private funding, this Nigeria example is positive. Then she briefly refers to the upcoming Migration Pact and the hope to bring it to the College before the summer break. We intend to strengthen and broaden our partnership with key countries of origin, transit and destination, including countries that host large numbers of refugees. These partnerships should be comprehensive and balanced and take the needs and priorities

of both sides into consideration, reflecting the fact that cooperation on migration is in our joint interest. To do this, we intend to use all our instruments. She explains that the

adoption timing is not decided yet.

ICMPD agrees timing is sensitive. For the future, he offers close cooperation with MS (DE joined ICMPD and others will follow - EL, DK). To the Commissioner's question on the role of the diaspora, he replies that there are different situations, the more local the approach, the better it is. It is also about advantages to them, about trade issues. They would like to do more on this. Suggests that a reference should be includes in the Migration Pact.

The Commissioner agrees with this suggestion and suggests to touch basis again, once the Migration Pact is presented.
