

On 4/1, it was announced the Danish journalist Matilde Kimer, Russia and Ukraine correspondent for the national public broadcaster DR, had her Ukrainian accreditation reinstalled. The accreditation had been suspended by Ukrainian security services in August 2022 over alleged pro-Russian reporting — an decision which was widely judged as based on misunderstandings. In mid-December, the issue became public and created strong negative reactions in Danish public debates and from the side of national and international journalists' unions. The issue was only solved after Minister Rasmussen raised the case in a phone call with Minster Kuleba as one of his first public actions in office.
