

Dear Madam,

We are writing concerning your request for access to Commission documents registered on 4 April 2023 under case number 2023/2070.

In your request, you indicate that you request access to: "(...) documents containing the following information: For the years 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023 to date: - any and all documents mentioning Chatham House rules and/or the Chatham House rule. This includes - but is not limited to - all agendas of meetings, meeting reports, correspondence of any kind such as e-mails (including all attachments), briefings, presentations, notes and reports of any kind.(...)"

In line with [Regulation \(EC\) No 1049/2001](#) regarding public access to documents, we would like to ask you to please clarify whether you are requesting only for such documents that are held by DG FISMA or by the whole European Commission.

The 15 working days to reply to your request will start running only when you reply to this message. If you do not reply within 7 working days, we will close this case in line with our detailed rules for the application of Regulation (EC) No 1049/2001.
