


- Display of the incoming video data

Strengthening the Schengen area


- With PerIS...

Future Features


PerIS is an extendible system which can be customised to the customer needs





API vs. PNR



Identified problem

Limited flight coverage for API data (65% of inbound flights, no intra-EU flights) leads to **security gaps**



Considerable economic **burden on air carriers** due to diverging national requirements on collection and transmission of API data



Poor data quality due to manual insertion of API data



Reconciling operational needs and legal requirements



Proposed solution

Covering all inbound and outbound flights and selected intra-EU flights

Harmonised requirements and data formats, EU centralised transmission through the router (efficiency gains for air carriers and Member States)

Automated means to collect API data to ensure **complete and reliable data**

Router as an EU solution that allows for the processing of API data (and PNR data) in compliance with the Court requirements




