<b>Partner</b>	The European Border and Coast Guard Agency (Frontex)
<b>Overall Objective</b>	The overall objective (impact) of this action is to contribute to enhancing border security in the Southern Neighbourhood, with the specific objective of increasing the capacity of Southern Neighbourhood countries for integrated border management.
<b>Result 1</b>	Increased awareness of cooperation opportunities with <b>Frontex</b> and <b>EU IBM practices</b>
<b>Result 2</b>	Increased awareness of <b>training</b> opportunities and increased institutional training capacities for integrated border management



## Thematic dimensions: examples

- Cross-border crime at the border: e.g. fight against trafficking of persons and smuggling of migrants including protection of vulnerable persons
- Border checks and traveler risk assessment at border crossing points: including detection of Persons of Interest
- Detection of document fraud
- Coast guard functions (including SAR workshops)
- Management of health security risks at the border
