PROPOSAL REJECTION DECISION

Horizon 2020 Framework Programme
Call: H2020-SU-SEC-2018-2019-2020

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 July 2018 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union, amending Regulations (EU) No 1296/2013, (EU) No 1301/2013, (EU) No 1303/2013, (EU) No 1304/2013, (EU) No 1309/2013, (EU) No 1316/2013, (EU) No 223/2014, (EU) No 283/2014, and Decision No 541/2014/EU and repealing Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 (hereafter the ‘Financial Regulation’)¹, and in particular Article 200(6) thereof,

Whereas:

In the framework of Horizon 2020 Framework Programme², and in accordance with the Work Programme/Work Plan 2018-2020³, the call H2020-SU-SEC-2018-2019-2020 (H2020-SU-SEC-2019) was published on 27 October 2017 – with deadline for submission by 22 August 2019.

Admissibility and eligibility checks were carried out on the proposal(s) received, in compliance with the rules in the work programme/call.⁴ An ethics review was carried out in order to check compliance with ethical principles and applicable international, EU and national law.

According to this ethics review, the proposal(s) listed in the Annex under ‘Failed ethics review’ did not receive ethics clearance, and should therefore be rejected.

Therefore, the proposal(s) listed in the Annex should be rejected. The specific reasons for rejection are set out, for each proposal, in that Annex,
